## ENROLMENT FEES:

A non-refundable application fee of \$50 is charged for each enrolment. Request for the fee will be made on lodgement of the application.

Upon an offer of a place in the College a deposit of \$300 is payable to confirm the placement. This deposit will be credited towards Term 1's fees.

## COLLEGE LEVIES

**GENERAL PURPOSE LEVY:** \$920 year per student  
The General Purpose Levy includes the Technology Levy and Excursion Levy

**P & F ASSOCIATION LEVY:** \$100.00 year per family

**CAMP LEVY:** \$250 year per student (incl. GST)  
Camp Fees are charged for Years 10, 11 and 12

**UNIFORM LEVY:** \$100 per year per senior student  
Senior students (Years 11 & 12) – covers the cost of a blazer and hat

**SEWING KIT:**

\$8 per junior student

Junior students (Years 7 only) - covers the cost of the sewing kit

**OTHER COSTS:**

School Uniforms, Home Economics ingredients as required, and some excursions (entry fee) as arranged throughout the year.

**NOTES****PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS:**

Parents are asked to pay the fee account within 14 days of issue. Payment is preferred by DIRECT DEBIT (no cost to you), however cash, cheque, EFTPOS, credit card, EFT are also acceptable. Each Fee statement includes an authority to pay by credit card.

**FUNDRAISING:**

From time to time co-curricular and charity groups within the college undertake specific fundraising e.g. MS Bikeathon, Caritas, Walk 4 Change (supports 5 charities)
